This program will provide an overview of metastatic breast cancer including incidence, prognosis, and diagnostic/staging considerations. Key patient and disease-specific factors critical to treatment decisions will be discussed. The NCCN guidelines for combining and sequencing chemotherapy, hormonal agents, anti-HER2 therapy as well as other novel targeted agents including CDK4/6 inhibitors and PI3K inhibitors will be reviewed.
