Description:

The MD Anderson Cancer Network Nursing Education Series is designed for oncology nurses within the Partner and Certified Member program and provides evidence-based oncology content. This learning activity will include information on the Commission on Cancer Standard 8.1 Barriers to Care and its impact on cancer care organizations, as well as examples of barriers to oncology care impacting cancer patients across the nation, and strategies to improve access to cancer care in the oncology setting. Specific efforts to decrease barriers to oncology care will be discussed, including the implementation of a meaningful survivorship program, an initiative to increase human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination rates, and strategies to address breast cancer care disparities in the African American population.
