Presentation Format

Poster Specifications

When creating your poster, please be aware of the following guidelines:

- Size: 42 inches x 42 inches (107 cm by 107 cm) Square. This size specification must be strictly adhered to in preparation of your posters. Posters that exceed this size limit will not be displayed.
- Material: The poster can be printed on one (1) sheet (rollup) or PolyFabric. Please DO NOT mount illustrations on heavy cardboard because they may be difficult to keep in position on the poster board.
- Formatting Requirements:
 - Font: Arial, size 11
 - Length: <300 words in the body of the abstracts</p>
 - Sections: Separate abstract into the below general categories and bold subheadings:
 - 1. Background
 - 2. Aims, Objective or Purpose
 - 3. Methods
 - 4. Results
 - 5. Conclusions/Implications

Review Process & Selection Criteria

Abstracts will be reviewed by the Faculty Organizing Committee. Abstracts will be evaluated based on alignment with the conference objectives, presentation, innovation, and scientific merit.
